Bids received in excess of the ABC for each lot shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

Delivery of the Goods is required within 180 days upon Opening of Letter of Credit. Bidders should have completed, within two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. Prospective bidders should be PhilGEPS registered with Platinum Membership and possess a valid Mayor's/Business permit applicable to the contract. In cases of recently expired Mayor's/Business

permits, it shall be accepted together with the official receipt as proof that the bidder has applied for renewal within the period prescribed by the concerned local government unit, provided that the renewed permit shall be submitted as a post-qualification requirement in accordance with Section 34.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184; must not have fifteen percent (15%) or more negative slippage in on-going projects and must have a recent Tax Clearance issued by the BIR Main Office filed through the EFPS (E.O. 398, s. 2005), if applicable. The complete description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Instruction to Bidders and Eligibility Requirements for the Procurement of Goods.

Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorship, partnership, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to the citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulation of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 518, and subject to Commonwealth Act 138.

Prospective bidders should have experience in undertaking a similar project within the last two (2) years, with an amount of at least 50% of the proposed project for bidding.

We also require that the prospective supplier/bidder should be:

- (1) MORE THAN TWENTY (20) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN SELLING BRAND NEW HEAVY EQUIPMENTS AND TRUCKS as certified by the company where the firm started from the SEC registration date with track record; must have a
- (2) CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION from the BUREAU OF CUSTOMS and a
- (3) PLATINUM MEMBER OF PHILGEPS; must have a
- (4) CERTIFICATE OF ACCREDITATION from the LAND TRANSPORTATION OFFICE
- (5) AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS for the year 2018 to 2020 with Income Tax Return filed thru EFPS
- (6) AVAILABILITY OF AFTER SALES SERVICE

Interested bidder may obtain further information from from LGU-Opol through BAC SECRETARIAT, Mr. Jose F. Escuzar, Jr. and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during Mondays to Fridays at 8 AM to 5 PM.

A complete set of Bidding Documents may be purchased by Interested Bidders on August 20, 2021 to September 10, 2021 from the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee for the Bidding Documents in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos Only (Php 50,000.00).

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS), provided that bidders shall pay the fee for the Bidding Documents not later that the submission of their bids.

Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before September 13, 2021 9:00 AM. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Securing Declaration, or any form of Bid Security, in an amount not less than the

required percentage of the ABC in accordance with the following schedule, denominated in Philippine Pesos and posted in favor of the Procuring Entity, to wit:

b) Bank draft/ guarantee or irrevocable letter of credit issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank: Provided, however, that it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a Universal or Commercial Bank, if issued by a foreign bank.  For biddings conducted by LGUs, bank draft/ guarantee, or irrevocable letter of credit may be issued by other banks certified by the BSP as authorized to issue such financial instrument.	
c) Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security.	Five percent (5%)

Bid Opening shall be on September 13, 2021, 10:00 AM at the BAC OFFICE. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidder's representative who chooses to attend the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

The MUNICIPALITY OF OPOL, MISAMIS ORIENTAL reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
