**Resolution No. 2023- 42**

**A Resolution Authorizing the Local Chief Executive, Municipal Mayor, Jayfrancis D. Bago, to Grant Dr. Janessa S. Pahillan-Bearneza a monthly salary of Fifty-Two Thousand Pesos (PhP52,000.00) as Medical Doctor on a Job Order Status**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Local Government Code expressly states every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

**WHEREAS**, Section 77 of the Code likewise provides that the chief executive of every local government unit shall be responsible for human resources and development in his unit and shall take all personnel actions in accordance with the Constitutional provisions on civil service, pertinent laws, and rules and regulations thereon, including such policies, guidelines and standards as the Civil Service Commission may establish: provided, that the local chief executive may employ emergency or casual employees or laborers paid on a daily wage or piecework basis and hired through job orders for local projects authorized by the sanggunian concerned, without need of approval or attestation by the Civil Service Commission;

**WHEREAS**, in a letter dated January 11, 2023, the Municipal Health Officer, Emily Grace G. Banal, MD, MPSM, requested, through the Municipal Mayor, Atty. Jayfrancis D. Bago, an urgent resolution from the Sangguniang Bayan authorizing the Local Chief Executive to grant a monthly salary of Fifty-Two Thousand Pesos (PhP52,000.00) to Janessa S. Pahillan-Bearneza, who is a licensed physician and employed as job order medical doctor for a period of January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023;

**WHEREAS**, in an urgent letter dated January 13, 2023, the Local Chief Executive, Mayor Jayfrancis D. Bago, requested the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan to pass a Resolution authorizing him to grant Dr. Janessa S. Pahillan-Bearneza a monthly salary of Fifty-Two Thousand Pesos (PhP52,000.00) for being employed as job order medical doctor;

**WHEREFORE**, on the motion presented by Hon. Roland B. Alfeche, and duly seconded by Hon. Danilo O. Daroy; it was


