Resolution No. 2023- 55

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PROPOSED REVISED ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF OPOL, MISAMIS ORIENTAL

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code expressly states every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Code provides that local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code;

WHEREAS, Section 76 of the Code mandates every local government unit to design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capability, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission;

WHEREAS, Section 77 of the Code likewise provides that the chief executive of every local government unit shall be responsible for human resources and development in his unit and shall take all personnel actions in accordance with the Constitutional provisions on civil service, pertinent laws, and rules and regulations thereon, including such policies, guidelines and standards as the Civil Service Commission may establish;

WHEREAS, in an urgent letter dated January 20, 2023, the Local Chief Executive, Mayor Jayfrancis D. Bago, requested the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan to promulgate a Resolution approving the proposed Revised Organizational Structure of the Local Government Unit of Opol, Misamis Oriental;

WHEREAS, the Revised Organizational Structure will ensure that working teams are given appropriate tasks and career development in terms of public service and in compliance with the Devolution and Transition Plan (DTP) to avoid disapproval from the Civil Service Commission (CSC);

WHEREFORE, on the motion presented by Hon. Rhally Mae G. Piit, and duly seconded by Hon. Roland B. Alfeche; it was


RESOLVED, AS THE BODY HEREBY RESOLVES, to approve the Resolution Approving the Proposed Revised Organizational Structure of the Local Government Unit of Opol, Misamis Oriental.
