**Resolution No. 2023- 79**

**A RESOLUTION ALLOWING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, ATTY. JAYFRANCIS D. BAGO, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE TOURISM INFRASTRUCTURE AND ENTERPRISE ZONE AUTHORITY (TIEZA), REPRESENTED BY ITS CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER, MARK T. LAPID, AND ACCEPT THE FUNDS RELATIVE THERETO FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE TOURIST INFORMATION CENTER AND TOURIST REST AREA (GREEN RESTROOM) IN OPOL, MISAMIS ORIENTAL**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

**WHEREAS**, Section 17 of the Code likewise provides that local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 17 (b) (2) (xi) of the Code, local government units are mandated to provide basic services and facilities such as, but not limited to, tourism facilities and other tourist attractions, including the acquisition of equipment, regulation and supervision of business concessions, and security services for such facilities;

**WHEREAS**, Section 444 (b) (1) (vi) of the Code states that the Municipal Mayor shall exercise general supervision and control over all programs, projects, services, and activities of the municipal government, and in this connection, shall, upon authorization by the Sangguniang Bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance;

**WHEREAS**, the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA) has a mandate to develop, manage and supervise tourism infrastructure projects in the country. Fortunately, the Municipality of Opol is one of the recipients of its projects;

**WHEREAS**, in an urgent letter dated February 9, 2023, the Local Chief Executive, Mayor Jayfrancis D. Bago, requested the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan of Opol to pass a Resolution allowing him to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement with the Tourism Infrastructure and Enterprise Zone Authority (TIEZA), represented by its Chief Operating Officer, Mark T. Lapid, and accept the funds relative thereto for the implementation of the Tourist Information Center and Tourist Rest Area (Green Restroom) in Opol, Misamis Oriental;




**WHEREFORE**, on motion presented by Hon. Danilo O. Daroy, and duly seconded by Hon. Palmero F. Ebonia; it was
