Resolution No. 2023- 136

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, MAYOR JAYFRANCIS D. BAGO, TO GRANT A MONTHLY SALARY OF FIFTY-TWO THOUSAND PESOS (PHP52,000.00) TO DR. ANNA GRACE J. MENDOZA, A LICENSED PHYSICIAN, ON A JOB ORDER STATUS FOR THE PERIOD OF MARCH 8, 2023 TO JUNE 8, 2023

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code expressly states every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Code provides that local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to this Code;

WHEREAS, Section 77 of the Code likewise provides that the chief executive of every local government unit shall be responsible for human resources and development in his unit and shall take all personnel actions in accordance with the Constitutional provisions on civil service, pertinent laws, and rules and regulations thereon, including such policies, guidelines and standards as the Civil Service Commission may establish: provided, that the local chief executive may employ emergency or casual employees or laborers paid on a daily wage or piecework basis and hired through job orders for local projects authorized by the sanggunian concerned, without need of approval or attestation by the Civil Service Commission;

WHEREAS, in an urgent letter dated March 31, 2023, the Municipal Mayor, Atty. Jayfrancis D. Bago, requested the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan to issue a Resolution authorizing him to grant a monthly salary of Fifty-Two Thousand Pesos (Php52,000.00) to Dr. Anna Grace J. Mendoza, who is a licensed physician and employed as job order medical doctor for a period of March 8, 2023 to June 8, 2023;


WHEREFORE, in a motion presented by Hon. Rhally Mae G. Piit, and duly seconded by Hon. Roland B. Alfeche; it was




