Resolution No. 2023- 144

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, MAYOR JAYFRANCIS D. BAGO, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT WITH THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT (OP), REPRESENTED BY ITS ASSISTANT SECRETARY, ADRIAN CARLOS A. BERSAMIN, TO UNDERTAKE AND AGREE TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE GUIDELINES ON THE MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION OF THE SOCIO-CIVIC PROJECT FUND (SCPF) AMOUNTING TO TEN MILLION PESOS (PHP10,000,000.00) TO SUPPORT THE SEVEN (7) SOCIAL SERVICES PROGRAMS OF THE MUNICIPAL SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (MSWDO) OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF OPOL, MISAMIS ORIENTAL

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Code provides that local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated therein;

WHEREAS, Section 17 (2) (b) (iv) of the Code states that local government units are mandated to provide basic services and facilities, such as, but not limited to, social welfare services which include programs and projects on child and youth welfare, family and community welfare, women's welfare, welfare of the elderly and disabled persons; community-based rehabilitation programs for vagrants, beggars, street children, scavengers, juvenile delinquents, and victims of drug abuse; livelihood and other pro-poor projects; nutrition services; and family planning services;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17 (f) of the Code, the national government or the next higher level of local government unit may provide or augment the basic services and facilities assigned to a lower level of local government unit when such services or facilities are not made available or, if made available, are inadequate to meet the requirements of its inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the President may, upon request of the local government unit concerned, direct the appropriate national agency to provide financial, technical, or other forms of assistance to the local government unit. Such assistance shall be extended at no extra cost to the local government unit concerned¹;

WHEREAS, Section 444 (b) (1) (vi) of the Code mandates that the Municipal Mayor shall exercise general supervision and control over all programs, projects, services, and activities of the municipal government, and in this connection, shall, upon authorization by the Sangguniang Bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, in an urgent letter dated April 14, 2023, the Local Chief Executive, Mayor Jayfrancis D. Bago, requested the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan of Opol to issue a Resolution authorizing him enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Office of the President (OP), represented by Assistant Secretary Adrian Carlos A. Bersamin, to undertake and agree to the implementation of the Guidelines on the Management and Administration of the Socio-Civic Project Fund (SCPF) amounting to Ten Million Pesos (PhP10,000,000.00) as support to the Seven (7) Social Services Programs of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) of the Municipality of Opol, Misamis Oriental;

WHEREAS, the Seven (7) Social Services Programs of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO) are the following:

- 1) Financial assistance to eligible students from indigent/low-income earner families;
- 2) Financial assistance for Burial, Hospitalization, Medical Treatment, Transportation, and Subsidy to the Victims of Abuse, and Emergency Assistance Program for Individuals in Crisis Situations;
- 3) Monthly subsidy to indigent/eligible PWDs under the Person with Disability (PWD) Welfare Program;
- 4) Monthly subsidy to indigent non-pensioner citizens under the Senior Citizen's Welfare Program;
- 5) Monthly subsidy for indigent solo parents under the Solo Parent Welfare Program;
- 6) Livelihood assistance to all sectors; and
- 7) Skills Training for 4Ps beneficiaries.

WHEREFORE, in a motion presented by Hon. Danilo O. Daroy, and duly seconded by Hon. Roland B. Alfeche; it was


