**Resolution No. 2023- 152**

**A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST FOR FUNDING FROM THE OFFICE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT, REPRESENTED BY ITS SECRETARY, AMENAH F. PANGANDAMAN, FOR THE SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF SOLAR STREETLIGHTS IN BARANGAYS TABOC, MALANANG, AWANG, BAGOCBOC, AND TINGALAN, OPOL, MISAMIS ORIENTAL IN THE AMOUNT OF TWENTY-FIVE MILLION PESOS (PHP25,000,000.00)**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991 states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

**WHEREAS**, Section 17 of the Code likewise provides that local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to 17 (b) (2) (viii) of the Code, local government units are mandated to provide basic services and facilities such as, but not limited to, infrastructure facilities intended primarily to service the needs of the residents of the municipality and which are funded out of municipal funds including but not limited to, municipal roads and bridges; school buildings and other facilities for public elementary and secondary schools; clinics, health centers and other health facilities necessary to carry out health services; communal irrigation, small water impounding projects and other similar projects; fish ports; artesian wells, spring development, rainwater collectors and water supply systems; seawalls, dikes, drainage and sewerage, and flood control; traffic signals and road signs; and similar facilities;

**WHEREAS**, Section 447 (a) (5) (v) of the Code provides that local government units shall, through the Sangguniang Bayan, regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same; establish bus and vehicle stops and terminals or regulate the use of the same by privately-owned vehicles which serve the public; regulate garages and the operation of conveyances for hire; designate stands to be occupied by public vehicles when not in use; regulate the putting up of signs, signposts, awnings and awning posts on the streets; provide for the lighting, cleaning and sprinkling of streets and public places;

**WHEREAS**, in an urgent letter dated April 27, 2023, the Local Chief Executive, Mayor Jayfrancis D. Bago, requested the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan of Opol to pass a Resolution to request for funding from the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), represented by its Secretary, Amenah F. Pangandaman, for the supply and installation of Solar Street-

lights in Barangays Taboc, Malanang, Awang, Bagoceboc, and Tingalan, Opol, Misamis Oriental in the amount of Twenty-Five Million Pesos (PHP25,000,000.00);

**WHEREAS**, the installation of more streetlights will reduce the accident rate, prevent criminal or illegal activities, and help motorists in their travel in the hinterland barangays of Opol, Misamis Oriental;

**WHEREFORE**, in a motion presented by Hon. Danilo O. Daroy, and duly seconded by Hon. Palmero F. Ebonia; it was


