Resolution No. 2023- 193

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, ATTY. JAYFRANCIS D. BAGO, TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (DOH), REPRESENTED BY DIRECTOR IV JOSE R. LLACUNA, JR., MD, MPH, CESO III, AND DR. AISHA V. PAPORO, RURAL HEALTH PHYSICIAN ASSIGNED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF OPOL, MISAMIS ORIENTAL

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code expressly states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of the Code provides that local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to the Code;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to protect and promote the right to health of all Filipinos and instill health consciousness among them. Towards this end, the State shall adopt an integrated and comprehensive approach to ensure that all Filipinos are health literate, provided with healthy living conditions, and protected from hazards and risks that could affect their health. It shall also adopt a health care model that provides all Filipinos access to a comprehensive set of quality and cost-effective, promotive, preventive, curative, rehabilitative and palliative health services without causing financial hardship, and prioritizes the needs of the population who cannot afford such services³;

WHEREAS, Section 444 (b) (1) (vi) of the Code mandates that the Municipal Mayor shall exercise general supervision and control over all programs, projects, services, and activities of the municipal government, and in this connection, shall, upon authorization by the Sangguniang Bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, in an urgent letter dated June 16, 2023, the Local Chief Executive, Mayor Jayfrancis D. Bago, requested the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan of Opol to issue a Resolution authorizing him to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Health (DOH), represented by Director IV Jose R. Llacuna, Jr., MD, MPH, CESO III, and Dr. Aisha V. Paporo, Rural Health Physician assigned in the Municipality of Opol, Misamis Oriental;

WHEREAS, the DOH implements the Human Resource for Health (HRH) Deployment Program to promote access to quality health services to the marginalized, vulnerable and disadvantaged population of the country, to improve health outcomes and contribute to the attainment of health-related Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The program includes Doctors to the Barrio Program which aims to deploy physicians in priority areas especially to those hard to reach, far flung, doctorless municipalities for the purpose of assisting the improvement of local public health systems therein;

WHEREFORE, in a motion presented by Hon. Roland B. Alfeche, and duly seconded by Hon. Palmero F. Ebonia; it was


