**Resolution No. 2023- 197**

**A RESOLUTION ADDRESSED TO THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE, MAYOR JAYFRANCIS D. BAGO, FOR THE CREATION OF TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP TASKED IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF ORGANIC AGRICULTURE**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Local Government Code expressly states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

**WHEREAS**, Section 17 of the Code provides that local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated therein;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 17 (b) (2) (i) of the Code, the local government units shall provide basic services and facilities such as, but not limited to, extension and on-site research services and facilities related to agriculture and fishery activities which include dispersal of livestock and poultry, fingerlings, and other seedling materials for aquaculture; palay, corn, and vegetable seed farms; medicinal plant gardens; fruit tree, coconut, and other kinds of seedling nurseries; demonstration farms; quality control of copra and improvement and development of local distribution channels, preferably through cooperatives; inter-barangay irrigation system; water and soil resource utilization and conservation projects; and enforcement of fishery laws in municipal waters including the conservation of mangroves;

**WHEREAS**, under Section 36 of the Code, a local government unit may, through its local chief executive and with the concurrence of the sanggunian concerned, provide assistance, financial or otherwise, to such people's and non-governmental organizations for economic, socially-oriented, environmental, or cultural projects to be implemented within its territorial jurisdiction;

**WHEREAS**, on June 22, 2023, the Committee on Agriculture conducted a committee meeting with the Opol Municipal Federation of Farmers Association. One of the recommendations of the committee is for the creation of technical working group which will be tasked in the implementation of organic agriculture;

**WHEREFORE**, in a motion presented by Hon. Glee A. Jacalan, and duly seconded by Hon. Eliezer A. Vacalares, Jr.; it was




