**Resolution No. 2023- 199**

**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE MUNICIPAL SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (MSWDO) MANUAL OF OPERATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 16 of the Local Government Code expressly states that every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare;

**WHEREAS**, Section 17 of the Code provides that local government units shall endeavor to be self-reliant and shall continue exercising the powers and discharging the duties and functions currently vested upon them. They shall also discharge the functions and responsibilities of national agencies and offices devolved to them pursuant to the Code. Local government units shall likewise exercise such other powers and discharge such other functions and responsibilities as are necessary, appropriate, or incidental to efficient and effective provisions of the basic services and facilities enumerated therein;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 17 (b) (2) (iv) of the Code, the local government units shall provide basic services and facilities such as, but not limited to, social welfare services which include programs and projects on child and youth welfare, family and community welfare, women's welfare, welfare of the elderly and disabled persons; community-based rehabilitation programs for vagrants, beggars, street children, scavengers, juvenile delinquents, and victims of drug abuse; livelihood and other pro-poor projects; nutrition services; and family planning services;

**WHEREAS**, in an urgent letter dated June 19, 2023, the Local Chief Executive, Mayor Jayfrancis D. Bago, requested the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan of Opol to issue a Resolution adopting the Operations Manual of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO);

**WHEREAS**, the MSWDO's Operations Manual is indispensable in the implementation of all social welfare and development activities and services provided by the municipality for its constituents;




